Lesson Plan Cat Mosaics

Class Duration: 30 minutes Tour Duration: 1 hour

Goals: Teach students the importance of camouflage for wild animals and allow students to camouflage their own cat.

Supplies:

- Furs
- Glitter
- Glue Sticks
- Small pieces of construction paper
- Sheets with cat outlines

Education:

	Show students the different cat furs
	Think of reasons that fur is important and how it lets them blend in to avoid being seen; use observations to describe patterns of what plants and animals need to survive (hide from predators and catch prey)
	Pass out one cat card to each student, glue sticks and decorations
	Tell the students that they are in charge of camouflaging their cat
	After decorations are complete, let the students share their cat with the class and explain why they camouflaged them the way they did.
