



Reminder Checklist

To be best prepared for your field trip to the Project Survival Cat Haven, please review the following recommendations to make your trip comfortable.

- ✓ Make sure you wear good walking shoes – no flip-flops or high-heels
- ✓ Pay attention to the weather. Bring a light jacket or sweatshirt for cooler days. Bring a hat or sun block for sunny days. Bring an umbrella for rainy days.
- ✓ Bring a drink for the tour; we have no water fountains on-site. Drinks are available for purchase, but drinks can always be brought in for your tour.
- ✓ Don't forget your camera; take as many pictures as you like
- ✓ Money for the gift shop; we have drinks and snacks available for purchase as well as cat-themed souvenirs. Souvenir pricing starts at just \$.50
- ✓ Bagged lunch if you will be eating at our facility; we have picnic tables available which overlook the Tiger enclosure
